# POT™

The Pot™ lounge chair designed by Arne Jacobsen. The chair was created along with the Egg™ and the Swan™ for the SAS Royal Hotel in Copenhagen in 1959.

Today, the lounge chair is relaunched with the purpose of complementing contemporary interiors with yet another 50s design from Arne Jacobsen.

#### **DESIGNER**

The collaboration between Arne Jacobsen and Fritz Hansen dates back to 1934. It was not until 1952 however that the team got its breakthrough with the Ant™. It was succeeded by Series 7™ in 1955, thereby enabling both Jacobsen and Fritz Hansen to write their names into furniture history.

#### MODELS

3318: Lounge chair

Shell: The shell is made of a combination of moulded hard and soft (MDI) polyurethane foam, reinforced with metal frame and with glass fiber enforcement edges before the chair is upholstered with fabric or leather.

Bases: The base consists of four legs in Brown bronze powder coated or chromed steel.

# **PRODUCTION PROCESS**

Shell: The shell of the  $\mathsf{Pot}^{\scriptscriptstyle\mathsf{TM}}$  is made of combination of moulded hard and soft (MDI) polyurethane foam with glass fibre reinforcement. The shell is padded with polyurethane (PUR) foam. A water-soluble glue is used for bonding of textile to the foam.

Upholstery: The Pot™ chair is available with upholstery. Several textiles are available with EU Ecolabel Flower mark.

Base: The bases are made of chromed steel or powder coated steel. Fritz Hansen uses both trivalent chromium (Cr3) and hexavalent chromium (Cr6) for chromium plating. Fritz Hansen will convert to solely using trivalent chromium (Cr3) when the capacity in the Industry allows it.


